Rules

- Adult & Junior Divisions. 5 member teams, registration costs \$150 per team.
Nonrefundable. Max of 8 teams in each division, double elimination bracket. Bracket position, lanes, and bed will be drawn for. The bracket will be drawn before Calcutta.
 - **Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. As there is a max of 8 teams, your team will not be registered until your payment has been received. You can pay online via Paypal or write & mail a check to LCCDC PO BOX 553 Chester, MT 59522**
- Each team will use provided bed frames. No alterations to be made of beds.
- Straight line race, approximately one block long. Will be disqualified if you go out of bounds.
- One team member must be riding on the bed at ALL times. Team players must take turns riding on the bed frame. All team members must have had a turn as a rider before any member of the team can ride again. All 5 members must be in contact with the bed when it goes across the finish line.
- If a team advances to the next round, a different rider must ride on the bed in the next race.

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- Pay out of entry fees: 45% for first place, 25% for second place, 10% for third place.
 - 20% goes back to the Hi-Line Harvest Festival. An engraved Traveling Trophy handmade by Cary Kolstad of Ick Metal will be given to the 1st place winner.

Calcutta

The Calcutta will take place at approximately 12:30 PM - 1:30 PM, in front of the Public Library.

Teams in both the **Junior** and **Adult** divisions will be auctioned to the highest bidder before the races.

The bidder who purchases the **winning team** in each division will receive **75% of that division's Calcutta pot**, while the remaining **25% will go directly to the Hi-Line Harvest Festival** to help support this annual community tradition.
