I agree to the following conditions in order to operate and obtain this booth:

- 1. Payment for the space leased must be made in full before the booth can be opened for business. Payment for the booth is non-refundable for any reason.
- 2. Vendor spots are 10x10 feet and outdoors. Please plan according to the weather!
- 3. Setting up may begin on Saturday, September 13th at 9:00 AM. All booth types will be set up and operable by 12:30 PM on September 13th. Vendors are required to stay open for the following hours
 - a. Craft Vendors: 1:00 PM 6:00 PM with the option of staying open later.
 - b. Food Vendors Noon 8:00 PM with the option of staying open until 10:30 PM.
- 4. The area assigned to me will always be kept neat and clean. I will meet any health, safety and sanitation conditions required for the type of booth I have. The Hi-Line Harvest Festival will not be responsible for maintenance of any equipment, nor furnish tools to maintain any displays or equipment.

- 5. All vendor types must provide their own booth power, table(s), chair(s), and canopy.
- 6. It is expressly understood that the space rented is for my exclusive use and cannot be subleased.
- 7. Anyone selling knives, firearms, or any type of weapon, will be removed from the fairground immediately. They will forfeit any fees paid and will be banned from the Hi-Line Harvest Festival.
- 8. I will always conduct myself in a courteous and professional manner.
- 9. The fee paid includes one (1) auto pass. Vehicles may be used to set up and stock the booth. All vehicles will be parked in the designated parking lot by 11:00 A.M.
- 10. Load out must be finished by the end of the festival on Saturday, September 13th by 10:30 PM for craft/org, and midnight for food vendors.
